Remember to Disinfect & Clean Common Touchpoints.

What is the difference between cleaning and disinfecting?

- * Cleaning is the removing of visible foreign matter from a surface.
- * Disinfecting is killing the bacteria and viruses on a surface. It is possible to be clean but not disinfected, and similarly disinfected but not clean.

Follow the instructions on the label of hospital provided products to ensure that disinfection is done properly. In order to be effective, some products must sit on the surface for a number of minutes before being wiped away. Refer to the product label for specifics about required dwell time.
